support of NYLCV President Julie Tighe and Congressman Adriano Espaillat.




As our own Adam Cohen wrote in a song for the evening:

"Road trippin' with my NineDot allies, fully charged for the peaker plant demise.


It's time to green this town, it's time for carbon free.

\$40 million tax equity financing

NineDot Energy has secured its **first ever tax equity financing**, facilitated by **Monarch Private Capital** and involving seven battery storage sites, which will bring in over \$40 million. With more than **50 projects** in development, construction, or operation, this capital supports our work in providing clean, reliable energy to NYC neighborhoods—<u>like how our Bronx site supported the grid</u> during this summer's heat waves. This financing brings our total capital raised to **\$450 million**.



Moving beyond "stationary" storage

At NineDot, stationary, community-scale batteries are the mainstay of our business, but we have been **exploring opportunities to expand our presence into electric vehicle charging and mobile battery solutions**. During NYC Climate Week, we had the chance to spend time with fellow advocates of this approach.

First, we <u>co-hosted a happy hour with partners across the battery and EV industries</u>. Later, we celebrated our award from <u>The Clean Fight Energy Storage Capital Challenge</u>, which will help bring our first mobile battery project to life in NYC. This project, featuring NY-manufactured batteries from <u>Viridi</u>, will demonstrate how mobile batteries can be a cleaner alternative to diesel generators, especially in congested areas like New York City.

Building community connections
