Battery storage in the Northeast Bronx

On August 9, 2022, we unveiled our first [battery site](#). One year later, we're excited to share that this site is now live and responding to Con Edison's call to ~~provide~~ provide load relief to one of the highest-stress areas of the City Northeast Bronx. This is an important step in replacing the Bronx's dirtiest ("peaker") power plants. Battery storage projects like this one will make neighborhoods cleaner and more energy-secure for decades to come.

We're thrilled to announce that on July 20, we closed a [\\$25 million](#) revolving credit debt facility provided by NY Green Bank — its first purely storage transaction — to help fund the interconnections to our growing pipeline of battery storage projects.
