On October 14, a rain-soaked but happy Saturday morning, NineDot Energy and the [Bronx Charter School for Better Learning 2](#) (BBL2) revealed a spectacular mural — named *Clean Energy* — created by students under the guidance of artist [Tijay Mohammed](#) and based on their ideas and hopes of what a clean energy city would look like. Battery storage supports EVs

[In September, we joined City Council Majority Leader Keith Powers, the Sierra Club, South Bronx Unite and more to reiterate our support of the ZEV for NYC Act](#), legislation that would require NYC to transition most of its municipal fleet to zero-emission vehicles by July 2035. Mayor Adams signed the legislation into law on Monday, October 23!

Our work to deploy EV infrastructure at our projects across the Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn and Staten Island began with our first EV program in Brooklyn, the only operational vehicle-to-grid installation in the City, which was built in partnership with local clean energy companies Revel and Fermata Energy.
