On 10.25.23, I was thrilled to have had the privilege of sharing our Clean Energy Mural story at the NineDot Energy's historic battery site, with esteemed policymakers and implementers from the Mayor's Office, Office of Climate and Environmental Justice, alongside members of key city agencies, such as the **Department of Buildings, NYC** Housing Authority, and NYC **Department of Administrative Services.** Councilmember Marjorie Velazquez also graced us with her presence, highlighting the significance of our shared vision. This initiative celebrates the intersection of art, sustainability, clean energy, and the power of community collaboration. Our gathering was a testament to what can be achieved when a community unites behind a common goal.

Our partnership began early this year, as students at Bronx Charter School for Better Learning embarked on a STEM program, generously funded by **NineDot Energy**. Under the guidance and tutelage of local artist **Tijay Mohammed** and with the invaluable assistance of **ArtBridge**, a public art non-profit organization, our students created a vibrant and impactful mural. Mr. Tijay is

a patient but firm teaching artist who allowed our students to create without interference. This masterpiece embodies the values we hold dear and the actions necessary to secure a brighter future for generations to come. As Mr. Shubert Jacobs, Executive Director of Bronx Charter Schools for Better Learning, eloquently put it, "The mural speaks to the legacy we are building as a community." On October 14th, the mural was revealed to celebrate the hard work. creativity, and determination of our BBL students. To quote NineDot, it happened "through a rain-soaked but happy crowd" of nearly 200 people. At the event, Councilmember Marjorie Velazquez, a passionate advocate for clean energy, shared her thoughts, and our student council president, Mila Joseph, did an exceptional job as the emcee. It's worth mentioning that following the October 14th event, Mila continued to proudly showcase her NineDot-BBL cup throughout the day, garnering admiration from teachers who are impressed by her dedication to spread the message.



This is where it started. **Dr. Marilyn** Maye, our founding Board Member heard the construction noises during BBL2's graduation. She was so upset by the unsightliness of the installation right in front of the school where children have to pass every day. Dr. Maye managed to get a telephone number from the sign on the construction site, called and Adam Cohen picked up the phone. His prompt and inspiring response sparked a chain of wonderful events that ultimately led to this powerful collaboration. I agree with Karen Alter's idea that, "It's a great lesson to all of us — when a neighbor calls, answer the phone." Adam's answer inspired Dr. Maye to reach out to our administrators who passed the baton to me. I ran with it. And here we are today, celebrating the most wonderful partnership with a group of people who, unlike other companies that provide sponsorship for school programs, is not looking for praises and accolades, but aimed at ensuring that our future generation is poised to continue the mission.
